Position Summary:

The primary role of the Land Stewardship Intern will be to provide support to the land stewardship team in fulfilling conservation easement annual monitoring obligations. The Land Stewardship Intern will have a variety of tasks as listed below, as well as the opportunity to spend time on beautiful protected properties, giving the intern relevant experience and a window into the work of landscape conservation and stewardship.

Responsibilities:

- Schedule conservation easement monitoring visits with landowners;
- Prepare materials for conservation easement monitoring visits;
- Accompany the land stewardship team on monitoring visits to private properties around the Lowcountry;
- Organize and digitize land protection documentation;
- Other tasks as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Degree-seeking students at a college or university;
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills;
- Strong organizational skills;
- Professional and customer service oriented.

Compensation:

The Intern will have the opportunity to work up to 20 hours per week at a rate of \$15/ hr (maximum 200 hours).
